

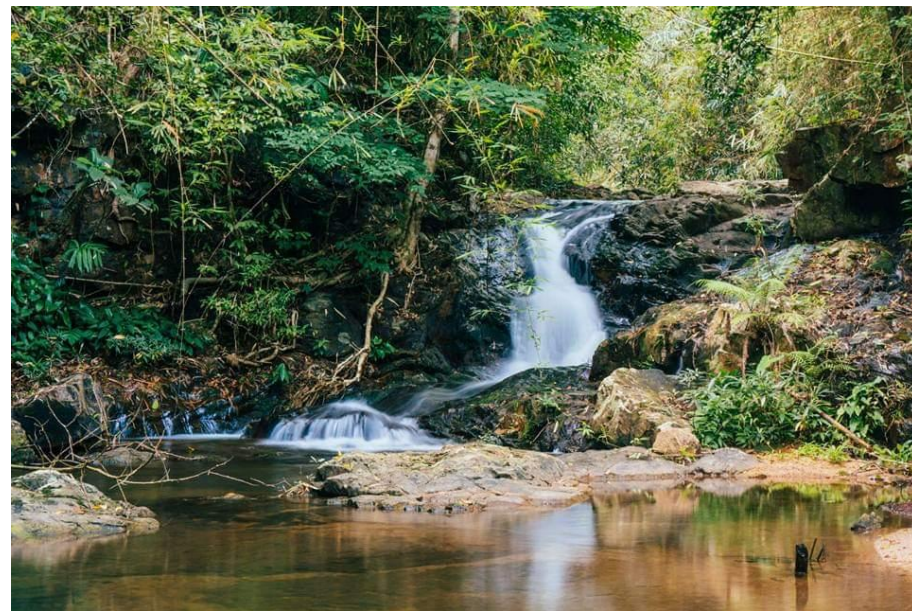
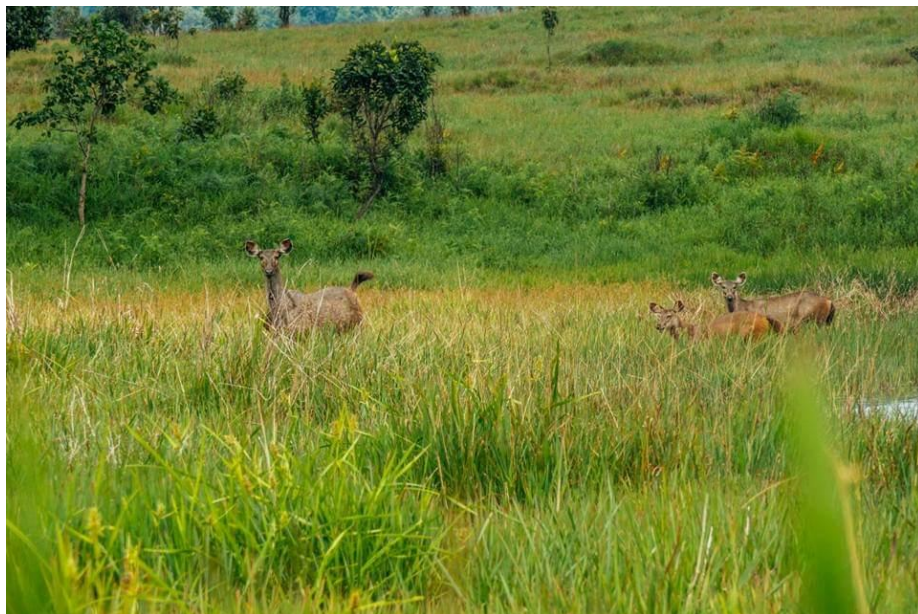

Perspectives & roles

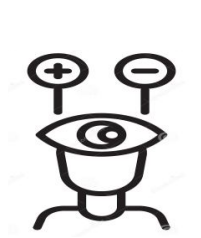
- ✓ Women play a key role in conservation, management and policy formulation

- ✓ Receive more attention from media



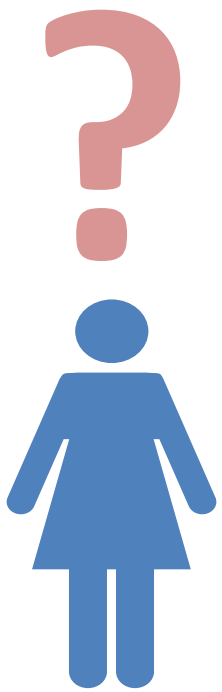


Socio-Cultural Norm

Impossible → **I'm Possible**


Helping others
